With an average weight of 20 lbs each, we re-furbished and re-used over 160k lbs of e-waste. Since 2006, we donated over **8,000 computer systems** to the Greater San Francisco Bay Area, and to several 3<sup>rd</sup> world countries through local non-profits. 344.5 volunteer hours and staff produced over 580 computer systems.
